 Sarath Chandra Janga leads a team of researchers who seek to identify the molecular players at different scales that interfere with the normal functioning of cellular related pathways and other related systems. Janga also has been working in the field of epigenetics, signaling, and metabolism.

**Jigman Yati**: Associate Professor, Bioinformatics  
 Jigman Yati works in the field of integrating data science to extract knowledge that can lead to better understanding of complex diseases, biological conditions, and interventions, such as Alzheimer's disease. Her research focuses on using genetic phenotypic association by combining efficient and scalable computational and bioinformatics approaches.

**Juwei Wang**: Assistant Professor, Bioinformatics  
 Juwei Wang has a long-standing interest in studying machine learning algorithms, tool development, and data analysis in bioinformatics. His academic training and research experience have provided him with an excellent background in multiple disciplines, including computer science, statistics, and computational biology.

**Rohan Khosroobak**: Assistant Professor, Bioinformatics, Data Science  
 Dr. Khosroobak's research group is pioneering the field of cardiac informatics, working at the nexus of bioinformatics and precision oncology. His researchers are working toward integrating computational biology and innovative (learning-based) approaches to illuminate novel cardiovascular (cardioinformatics) biology and create new therapeutics.

## Vachan Sankalp Maharashtracha






## Hands On Training



## Soft Skills Training and Mentoring
